Footnotes

LUNA NEGRA (IRE) fractious in the post parade and warm up, broke slowly, angled in and pulled her way along inside, saved ground stalking the pace, waited off heels leaving the second turn and into the stretch, came out in upper stretch, rallied to the front under some left handed urging to collar the leader in deep stretch, then inched away and held under a hold. BUSH TRIUMPH three deep early, was forced well wide on the first turn, stalked outside on the backstretch, bid three wide leaving the second turn, took a short lead near midstretch, fought back inside the winner and went willingly to the wire. OUR KYLEA floated out a bit into the first turn, dueled outside a rival then between horses into the stretch and nearing midstretch, could not match the top pair but held third. KILAUEA GIRL lugged out into the first turn, dueled inside a rival to midstretch, then weakened. DARLING LOVER forced well wide on the first turn, stalked between horses then outside a rival and also weakened. NEAR BETHANY bore out early on the first turn onto rivals and had the saddle slip, raced well off the rail and dropped back to lose any chance.
