Footnotes

SINGALONG (GB) angled in and saved ground off the pace, came out on the second turn and three deep into the stretch, made the lead four wide past midstretch and proved best under steady handling. SWEET DEE'S pulled her way along between horses then pressed the pace between foes, stalked inside leaving the turn, bid along the rail in the stretch and continued willingly for the place. GLASSY prompted the pace three deep then stalked outside the runner-up leaving the second turn, bid between foes past the eighth pole and bested the others. PRIVATE BANKING (FR) sped to the early lead, set a pressured pace inside, inched away on the second turn, was between horses past midstretch and weakened late. NEUILLY (BRZ) chased a bit off the rail or outside a rival, swung four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. TRADE ONLY pulled early, stalked a bit off the rail then inside, came out leaving the second turn, steadied off heels into the stretch, drifted in and lacked the necessary response.
