**Footnotes**

KONA GOLD between horses early, chased a bit off the rail, moved up on the turn, came three deep into the stretch, gained the advantage outside the runner-up nearing midstretch, pulled clear under a brisk hand ride while being shown the whip and was under a long hold late. NO ARMISTICE also between horses early, prompted the pace outside a rival, took a short lead nearing the stretch, battled inside the winner in midstretch, then could not match that one and just held second. KOMAX trailed along the inside, came out on the turn and into the stretch, split horses in midstretch and finished well. RADIATA allowed to settle off the inside chasing the leaders, came three deep into the stretch and lacked a rally. RAPIDOUGH wide early, also settled off the inside, angled to the rail on the turn, came out past midstretch and was not a threat. HOMBRE RAPIDO sent between horses early, dueled inside to the stretch, then weakened.
