KRIS' SIS pulled a bit early, stalked inside then a bit off the rail, bid outside the pacesetter on the backstretch and second turn, took the lead in upper stretch, lugged in a bit in midstretch and inched away late under left handed urging. MUSICAL HIGH (IRE) chased inside, came out in midstretch and split horses late for the place. SWEET DEE'S sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, fought back on the second turn and in the stretch and held third. I CAN SEE a bit slow to begin, chased just off the rail then outside a rival on the backstretch and second turn and just missed a minor award three deep on the line. RIVER MELODY (GER) angled in and saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally.
