Footnotes

LEMON DROP RIDGE saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and again in midstretch and rallied under urging to get up three deep on the wire. LILLY'S PERFECT was floated out into the first turn then went three deep on that turn, chased off the rail on the backstretch, went outside a rival on the second turn, came out three wide into the stretch, gained the lead in midstretch, fought back when headed in deep stretch and continued willingly between foes late. LIFT OUR LUCK pulled between horses and drifted out into the first turn, stalked outside a rival on the backstretch, angled in for the second turn, came out into the stretch, bid between foes nearing midstretch, put a head in front toward the inside in deep stretch and also went on gamely to the end. SCENT OF CHRISM squeezed some at the start, angled in and saved ground off the pace, came out in upper stretch and shared fourth place alongside the pacesetter late. WARREN'S PEACOCK pulled her way to the early lead and angled in, opened up on the backstretch, set the pace inside and weakened in the final furlong.
