KAYCE ACE three deep on the first turn, chased outside a rival, came out into the stretch, bid alongside the runner-up past midstretch and gamely prevailed under urging. ELLAFITZ stalked the leader a bit off the rail, bid alongside that one leaving the second turn, took the lead into the stretch, inched away nearing midstretch, fought back just off the rail in the final furlong and continued willingly. GRIPSHOLM CASTLE between horses early, chased a bit off the rail then inside ,came out on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and edged a rival for the show. ELVIES LANE saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch, split horses in midstretch and was outfinished. MEGASPIEL (GB) a bit slow into stride, angled in and settled outside a rival then a bit off the rail, found the fence on the second turn, came out in the stretch and did not rally. JAX EL sped to the early lead and angled in, set the pace inside, fought back some leaving the second turn but weakened in the stretch. MAKOMA settled a bit off the rail, dropped back leaving the backstretch and on the second turn, was pulled up and vanned off.
