KALOOKAN LASS saved ground chasing the leaders, came out into the stretch, gained the lead nearing midstretch and drew off under some urging and steady handling. DOUXRAH had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away leaving the second turn, could not match the winner but held second. LOVE THAT HILL off slowly and a bit awkwardly, was roused early and went three deep into the first turn, settled off the rail, came out into the stretch and picked up the show. SUNETTE four wide into the first turn, dueled three deep then outside a rival, came out into the stretch and weakened. NOSSENKO vied for command between horses then stalked off the rail, went three deep into the second turn, angled in some leaving that bend and also weakened. HOPE'S TRIUMPH four wide into the first turn, settled off the rail, angled in some on the second turn and did not rally. TINA'S LOVE was in a good position chasing outside a rival then a bit off the rail, angled in leaving the second turn and also weakened. BERRY SOUTHERN allowed to settle inside, saved ground and gave way, then collapsed when being pulled up into the clubhouse turn and was vanned off.
