JACOB'S JOURNEY chased off the rail, came out three deep into the stretch, rallied under urging to the front in deep stretch, inched away and held. MADEOFTHERIGHTSTUF broke a bit slowly, settled inside, came out leaving the turn and three deep into the stretch, angled to the far outside in the drive and finished well. WARREN'S CLOSER chased just off the rail, came out into the stretch, split rivals in deep stretch and got up for the show. NOFTY pulled a bit and stalked inside, continued along the rail in the stretch and was outfinished for third. SHANE DANIEL sped to the early lead and angled in, dueled along the rail leaving the turn, inched away a bit of the fence in the stretch, was between foes in deep stretch and weakened late. MR. SIERRA stalked the pace outside a rival, bid alongside the winner on the turn, fell back some in the stretch, was between foes past midstretch and also weakened late. WARREN'S PATRON broke a bit slowly, settled off the rail then angled in on the backstretch, saved ground on the turn and lacked the necessary response. ROYAL HEAT dwelt to be away well behind the field, galloped along far behind the field and was pulled up leaving the backstretch but walked off.
