**Footnotes**

LAKE BELIEVE sent between horses to the early lead off the rail, angled in on the first turn, set the pace inside, kicked clear on the second turn, drew away under urging in the stretch and held sway. HOT TICKET stalked between horses, was bumped midway on the second turn, came out some in the stretch and was clearly second best. WILD CAT LORE saved ground stalking the pace, was in a bit tight midway on the second turn, split rivals into the stretch, regained the rail in the drive and held third. TIA TIA bobbled slightly at the start, settled inside, came out some in the stretch and split horses on the line. LADY FOR A DAY bumped at the start, settled between rivals chasing the pace, continued alongside a rival into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. J AND S EXPRESS six wide into the first turn, moved up four wide on the backstretch to stalk the pace three deep, continued off the rail on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened. TOUCH LUCK pulled between horses early, stalked three deep on the first turn then a bit off the rail on the backstretch and second turn, angled in leaving that turn and also weakened. MYSTERY BIRD four wide into the first turn, stalked three deep, bumped with the runner-up then came out a bit midway on the second turn, entered the stretch three wide and had little left for the drive. SEXY MELODY five wide into the first turn, chased three deep, clipped heels midway on the second turn to drop back and lacked a response in the stretch. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the run on the second turn but made no change when they ruled MYSTERY BIRD was the cause of the trouble and that she and SEXY MELODY finished out of a mutual paying position.
