JUNIPER PASS chased inside then split horses leaving the backstretch, continued a bit off the rail leaving the second turn and into the stretch, came out in midstretch, rallied to the lead under urging in deep stretch and proved best. DUCANE stalked off the rail, bid alongside a rival on the backstretch and second turn, took a short lead in the stretch, inched away in midstretch, fought back in deep stretch but could not hold off the winner. MILYONE took the early lead and set the pace inside, dueled on the backstretch and second turn, fought back into the stretch and held third. DISTORTED ECONOMY stalked outside a rival, split foes early on the backstretch, went three deep approaching the second turn and alongside a rival into the stretch and was edged for the show. ISLE OF PRADO chased three deep or outside to the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. TAKE A YARD saved ground stalking the pace, dropped back on the second turn and weakened. BALBOA BAY a bit slow to begin, pulled his way along off the rail trailing the field, dropped well back on the second turn and was always outrun.
