Footnotes

FREE RANGE stalked inside down the backstretch and around the turn, angled out approaching the quarter pole and bumped a rival, bid for the lead at the eighth pole and drew away in the final furlong. MAKE MINE REMY sped to the early lead out of the chute, maintained the advantage inside down the backstretch and around the turn, relinquished the lead leaving the furlong marker, was no match for the winner but clearly second best. ZEES CHRIS stalked the pace on the outside down the backstretch, was bumped between horses nearing the quarter pole, weakened through the final furlong but was able to hold third. SILVER LUNA stalked the pace on the outside down the backstretch, moved up three deep around the turn, steadied when bumped nearing the quarter pole and weakened in the final eighth. KEY ALLEGRO was off a bit slowly, settled at the back of the pack, swung to the far outside in the drive and lacked the necessary rally. JUNES BLUE MOON pulled between horses in the early going, steadied off heels at the five eighths marker, angled inside through the drive and did not mount a rally. SOCIETY'S ORPHEN was off slowly, chased on the outside to the stretch, gave way and was eased through the final furlong.
