TWIRLING CANDY pulled hard along the inside then dropped back some in a bit tight on the backstretch, stalked between foes into and on the second turn, came out off heels nearing midstretch and rallied under a brisk hand ride to gain the lead in deep stretch then was under a long hold on the wire. SETSUKO close up stalking the pace outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch, was between horses past midstretch and got up three wide for the place. AGGIE ENGINEER angled in and dueled outside a rival, fought back in the stretch, was between horses past midstretch and held third between foes on the line. SOUL CANDY stalked the pace inside, moved up on the backstretch, waited a bit then split horses past midstretch and continued willingly toward the inside. SPURRIER chased a bit off the rail then inside, came out some in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. HONOUR THE DEPUTY settled off the rail then stalked three deep on the backstretch and second turn and into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. VICTORY PETE had good early speed and angled in, dueled inside, fought back on the second turn and in the stretch and weakened late.
