### Footnotes

ROI CHARMANT had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away into the turn, came off the rail into the stretch, drifted out through the drive but held gamely under urging. SHADOW OF ILLINOIS between horses early, chased off the rail, came out into the stretch and went willingly to the wire. WESTERN COMMENT chased outside then off the rail, came out into the stretch and also finished with interest. CAYAMBE settled a bit off the rail, went around a rival then angled in on the turn and lacked the needed rally inside. STORM BRAVE had speed outside then angled in and prompted the pace outside the winner, stalked just off the rail into and on the turn and weakened in the stretch. BIG SWISS allowed to settled along the inside, dropped back on the turn and lacked a further response.
