SIETE MACHOS broke in the air but quickly recovered and sped to the lead while drifting out into the first turn, angled in and inched away, kicked clear and set the pace a bit off the rail, drifted out from the whip in the stretch but held on gamely. DIPLO sent along outside a rival then pulled a bit, chased inside, came out in midstretch and edged a rival for the place. SARAVAS WILD AGAIN floated out into the first turn, chased outside a rival then off the rail, angled to the inside leaving the backstretch, continued toward the rail in the stretch and was edged for second. CAME ABOARD settled outside a rival then inside, went alongside a foe on the second turn and into the stretch, came out in the drive and was outfinished for a minor award. TIS allowed to settle off the pace inside, continued along the rail throughout and could not quite offer the necessary response in the stretch. SUMMERS AT DELMAR drifted out into the first turn, chased off the rail or outside a rival and lacked the needed rally. REALLY UPTOWN fanned wide into the first turn, prompted the pace outside a rival then stalked off the rail, continued alongside DIPLO on the second turn and weakened in the stretch.
