COST OF FREEDOM had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away on the turn, got clear and held on gamely under some urging. E Z'S GENTLEMAN was in a good position stalking the pace three deep to the stretch and continued willingly to the wire. MY SUMMER SLEW saved ground stalking the pace, came out some in upper stretch and bested the rest. M ONE RIFLE angled in and dueled outside the winner, stalked between foes leaving the turn, came out some in the stretch and weakened. HIYA SILVER a half step slow to begin, chased inside then a bit off the rail on the turn, split horses in the stretch and lacked the needed rally, then was vanned off after returning to be unsaddled with a missing left front shoe. JIGGLY stalked between horses or a bit off the rail, fell back some on the turn, angled to the inside into the stretch and weakened. BET ON VICTOR between horses early, stalked just off the rail, was in a bit tight off heels into the turn, went outside a rival leaving the turn, came out into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response.
