Footnotes

BEL AIR BELLE broke slowly, was taken off the rail and trailed early, began to advance leaving the backstretch, circled five then four wide on the turn, gained the lead outside a rival into the stretch and drew clear under some urging. BARTLEY had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away from foes leaving the turn, fought back inside the winner into the stretch, then was no match for that one but second best. STRATTER chased outside a rival on the backstretch and into the turn, moved up outside leaving the bend and five wide into the stretch and picked up the show. CATFIT vied for command three deep between horses, dropped back leaving the turn and weakened. GIRL TALK dueled four wide on the backstretch and turn, also dropped back a quarter mile out and weakened. THATSWHATSHESAID prompted the pace between horses, angled in leaving the turn and had little left for the stretch. ROYAL FOR SURE allowed to settle a bit off the rail on the backstretch, angled to the fence on the turn and failed to menace.
