SOUVENIR GIFT stalked off the rail, bid three deep on the turn, took a short lead leaving the bend, angled in and inched away into the stretch and drew clear under a light tap of the whip left handed and a steady hand ride until the final strides. FORTUNATE EVENT chased off the rail, angled in some for the turn, waited momentarily in a bit tight early on the turn, continued outside a rival, came out into the stretch and was clearly second best. SWISS PLEASE sent inside to duel for the lead, fought back on the turn, came a bit off the rail in upper stretch and held third. LUCK AND FAME stalked inside, steadied off heels nearing the turn, came out into the stretch, angled back in and lacked a further response. LADY SIPHONICA had good early speed and dueled outside a rival, battled between foes midway on the turn and weakened in the stretch. IREZA chased off the rail, dropped back on the turn, angled in leaving the bend and gave way.
