Footnotes

SELVATICA dueled inside on the backstretch, inched away on the turn, kicked clear under some urging in the stretch and held gamely. MEA DOMINA chased off the rail then along the inside, was in tight nearing the turn, moved up inside on the turn and into the stretch, came out a bit in midstretch and finished well. SPARKLING FOREST flipped and fell in the post parade, dueled outside the winner, stalked a bit off the rail on the turn and weakened but held third. AMMALU four wide early, stalked outside, went three deep on the turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed response. ANANDA PARADISA between horses early, moved up a bit off the rail leaving the backstretch, continued off the fence on the turn and weakened in the stretch. A SONG IN A MINOR unhurried off the rail then outside a rival to the stretch, failed to menace. SIENNA'S LANE had speed five wide then stalked outside, continued off the rail on the turn and weakened. FRAPPAY off a bit slowly, saved ground off the pace, came out in the stretch and was outrun. STORMY SENORITA had speed between horses then stalked off the rail, was between foes again into the turn, angled in leaving the bend and gave way.
