SUMMER WIND DANCER between foes early, angled in and chased inside, moved up into the second turn, came out into the stretch, bid outside the runner-up, took the lead past midstretch and inched away under urging. PESCI sped to the early lead, angled in on the first turn, set the pace inside, fought back inside the winner in midstretch, could not match that one late but was clearly best of the rest. MISS LOREN (ARG) chased outside then off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and gained the show late outside. SPARKLING AVA stalked the pace inside, came off the rail on the backstretch, continued outside the winner into and on the second turn, went three deep into the stretch and lost the show between foes late. HONEYPENNY four wide into the first turn, chased outside, angled in on the second turn, then was edged for third toward the rail. LADY THATCHER (CHI) bumped into the first turn, angled in on that bend and saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and did not rally. MAKEUP ARTIST bumped when three deep between foes into the first turn, moved up between horses on the backstretch, stalked outside the winner, dropped back and angled in on the second turn and gave way.
