FORT SUMTER stalked inside, came out in midstretch and again in deep stretch and rallied between foes under left handed urging to get up late. THE USUAL Q. T. chased outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and surged late five wide on the line to just miss. RAISE THE RIVER pulled his way between foes then stalked the pace, bid three deep on the turn and in the stretch and continued willingly between foes late to share the show. DIXIE PASSION stalked the pace off the rail then bid outside a rival, battled between foes on the turn and in the stretch, put a head in front in the drive and also went on willingly. DOHNSTER had good early speed and dueled inside then inched away on the backstretch, fought back along the fence on the turn and through the stretch and was outfinished. BOY NAMED SHOE settled off the rail, angled in on the turn, found the fence into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. DISCONTENT a bit slow to begin, chased just off the rail, was between horses in the stretch and could not summon the necessary response.
