**Footnotes**

CANDY RIDE (ARG) had good early speed between horses then dueled outside a rival, battled between foes again on the second turn and to midstretch, inched away past midstretch and pulled clear under some left handed urging. PRIMERICA stalked the pace outside then three deep on the backstretch, bid three wide on the second turn and into the stretch, could not match the winner but was clearly second best. BONUS PAY DAY angled in on the first turn and dueled inside, fought back on the second turn and to midstretch, then weakened some but held third. DAUNTING chased off the rail then found the fence leaving the first turn and stalked inside, came out into the stretch and weakened. GENERAL CHALLENGE off a bit slowly, was allowed to lag back inside, moved up along the rail on the second turn, came out in the stretch and was not a threat. PALMEIRO stalked three deep on the first turn and between horses on the backstretch, dropped back on the second turn and had little left.
