Footnotes

SKIMMING sped to the early lead off the rail, angled in leaving the first turn, set the pace inside, responded when the runner-up loomed a threat in the stretch and won clear under a crack of the whip and a strong hand ride. PATIENCE GAME chased along the inside early, advanced outside on the second turn and three deep into the stretch to loom a threat, then could not match the winner while best of the rest. LETHAL INSTRUMENT stalked the early pace inside then outside a rival on the backstretch, continued a bit off the rail on the second turn and into the stretch, also loomed a danger in midstretch, then weakened but held third. KOSLANIN (ARG) allowed to settle off the inside, moved up outside on the backstretch, continued off the rail and lacked a response in the stretch. MARK THE MOMENT stalked the winner outside a rival early, angled in on the backstretch, dropped back on the second turn and gave way.
