Footnotes

MEGAHERTZ (GB) saved ground chasing the pace, was in a bit tight into the second turn, waited along the rail in upper and midstretch, came out and rallied gamely between foes under strong handling to get up. ARABIC SONG (IRE) stalked the pace toward the inside, waited off heels a bit off the rail leaving the second turn and into the stretch, bid between horses in midstretch, gained a short lead and continued willingly but could not hold off the winner. HIGH SOCIETY (IRE) pulled three deep early, prompted the pace outside RED LITTLE LIES, bid three deep in midstretch and also continued willingly but was outfinished. ALOZAINA (IRE) broke slowly and steadied, trailed a bit off the rail, went outside the winner leaving the backstretch, split horses on the second turn, steadied off heels leaving that bend, continued boxed in entering the stretch, steadied again in tight approaching midstretch, came out and finished with interest. RED LITTLE LIES broke through the gate before the start, was reloaded, pulled her way to the front and the inside, set a slow but pressured pace along the rail, fought back in the stretch but was outkicked. DOC'S LIL' ANGEL was in a good position stalking the pace three deep to the stretch and weakened. LA MARTINA (GB) rank between horses early, stalked outside a rival, went three deep on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and also weakened.
