Footnotes

COBALT BLUE chased outside on the backstretch and turn, came three deep into the stretch and rallied under urging to get up late. FUTURE SEARCH had speed between foes then dueled outside a rival, kicked clear and angled in on the turn and was caught late. TOM RICKEY chased between horses then off the rail on the turn, swung out into the stretch and gained the show late. GRAN TENOR stalked off the rail then outside a rival on the turn, loomed a threat behind the runner-up in midstretch and lost third late. MR. NEGOTIATOR sent inside to stalk the pace, came a bit off the rail on the turn and weakened. STORMELLO a bit crowded early, chased outside then three deep, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. KING AT PLAY settled inside, saved ground until past midstretch and failed to menace. SILVER STATE between foes early, pressed the pace inside, steadied early on the turn, stalked along the rail and weakened in the stretch. AGREED AFFAIR broke a bit slowly, saved ground off the pace and was outrun. SPARK OF DUBAI chased outside or off the rail, split horses into the stretch and weakened.
