Footnotes

HOT KITTY forced the pace along the inside, took the lead in upper stretch, inched away in midstretch and drew clear under steady handling. PLEASE BE SEATED prompted the early pace three deep then stalked off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and was clearly second best. MADDIE'S TEMPER sped to the early lead then dueled between horses early, battled outside the winner to upper stretch, then weakened but held third. WAY SHARP broke inward and slowly, went up a bit off the rail to chase the leaders to the stretch and lacked a further response. L.A. LATTE settled off the rail then angled in leaving the backstretch, continued inside and did not rally. SINCEYOUWENTAWAY angled in and settled off the pace early, went outside a rival on the turn, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. SHESMYHUCKLEBERY stalked the pace three deep early then outside a rival, came out for the stretch and weakened. SUMONDA bobbled in an awkward start, trailed off the rail and was outrun.
