### Footnotes

LADY DI HUNTLEY saved ground chasing the pace, moved up inside to the lead into the stretch, came a bit off the rail and won clear under urging. RALSY chased between horses on the backstretch and a bit off the rail on the turn, came out into the stretch and gained the place late. PARTY PIRATE close up a bit off the rail then between horses on the backstretch and turn, was shuffled back nearing the stretch, continued inside and saved a share of third. ZODIAQUE tracked the leader four wide between foes on the backstretch and three deep on the turn and lacked the needed late kick. DAZZLING DIAMONDS also close up chasing between horses on the backstretch, was shuffled back nearing the turn, continued off the rail on the bend and did not rally. SULAYMONDO stalked the pace six wide on the backstretch and five wide into the turn, continued four wide on the bend and weakened. TARA NINA was in a good position five wide on the backstretch, dropped back some outside on the turn and also weakened. GRAZIE PAPA stumbled at the start but recovered quickly and sped to the lead, set the pace a bit off the rail, was between horses into the stretch and had little left in the drive.
