Footnotes

CHARLIZE angled in and dueled outside a rival, put a head in front nearing midstretch and inched away under left handed urging. MINNIE THE MOOCHER stalked the leaders off the rail, came out a bit in the stretch and edged a rival for second. LAKER GIRL went up inside to duel on a short lead, fought back into the stretch and until past midstretch, could not match the winner late and was edged for the place. REDMEANSGO chased between horses then off the rail, went three deep into the turn, came into the stretch alongside a foe, angled out in upper stretch and lacked the needed rally. BAY MINETTE unhurried off the rail early, angled in some for the turn, came out three deep into the stretch and was not a threat. AMAPOLA'S WISH stalked the pace off the rail, angled in leaving the turn and weakened. COLOMINAS chased a bit off the rail then between foes into the turn, continued just off the inside and also weakened. GEORGIA B angled in and saved ground chasing the pace, dropped back on the turn and into the stretch and had little left.
