Footnotes

AFTER MARKET settled inside then a bit off the rail, advanced outside on the second turn and into the stretch, rallied under some urging to collar the runner-up in deep stretch and won clear. LAVA MAN chased a bit off the rail, moved up boldly three deep to take the lead on the second turn, angled in some into the stretch, could not hold off the winner but was clearly second best. OBRIGADO (FR) a bit slow to begin, settled three deep then off the rail, split rivals in the stretch and picked up the show. FITZ FLAG (ARG) saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. PORFIDO (CHI) chased between horses then outside a rival, split foes three deep on the second turn and into the stretch, steadied in a bit tight in midstretch and could not summon the necessary response. LANG FIELD had good early speed and dueled inside, stalked leaving the second turn and weakened in the stretch. RED FORT (IRE) chased outside a rival, came out leaving the backstretch, went four wide on the second turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. VALIANT EFFORT pulled his way along to duel outside a rival, dropped back on the second turn, gave way and was eased in the stretch.
