TIZ AFIRE chased outside a rival, angled to the inside into the stretch, bid along the rail in the drive, gained the lead under urging in deep stretch and gamely prevailed. GET OFF THE SUGAR saved ground stalking the pace, bid inside to gain a short lead a quarter mile out, came out into the stretch, battled outside the winner past midstretch and continued willingly but could not quite match that one late. HEATED REBEL four wide early, angled in and stalked outside a rival, came out leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch and bested the others. ADD HEAT angled in and pressed the pace outside a rival, continued three deep leaving the second turn and into the stretch and weakened. PRESIDENTIAL CAUSE settled off the pace inside, saved ground, continued inside in the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. MEN ONLY sped to the early lead, angled in on the first turn, set a pressured pace inside, dueled between rivals leaving the second turn and weakened in the stretch. PAPANONIE four wide on the first turn, chased outside, came three deep into the stretch and did not rally. REALLY INDIAN three deep on the first turn, settled just off the inside and had no response in the stretch.
