Footnotes

NEVER chased off the rail, came out leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch and rallied under urging to wear down rivals late. DIFERENTKINDAGREAT three deep into the first turn, chased outside a rival, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch, bid three deep in midstretch, put a head in front in late stretch and was edged nearing the line but held second between foes. TURF AND SKY stalked the pace inside, came out on the second turn and three deep into the stretch, put a head in front between foes, fought back between horses through the final furlong and held third. WARREN'S PEPE had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back on the second turn and through the stretch and was outfinished in the final stages. RED EYE EXPRESS (IRE) chased outside a rival or off the rail, came three deep into the stretch, was in a bit close off heels in deep stretch and also was outfinished. POKER DAVE settled off the pace inside, came out on the backstretch, angled back in for the second turn, came out again in the stretch and could not offer the necessary late kick. FACE AND AN ACE broke slightly in the air but alertly, was a bit wide into the first turn, dueled outside a rival, briefly put a head in front on the backstretch, continued between horses leaving the second turn, dropped back into the stretch, angled in some and weakened.
