Footnotes

SHE'LL HEIR chased inside, split horses in a bit tight midway on the turn, awaited room inside into the stretch and until midstretch, came out for room, went between horses bumping with ROCKIN HEATHER just past the eighth pole, bid between horses a sixteenth out, gained the lead and proved best under good handling. SWISS WILD CAT stalked between horses on the backstretch and turn, was bumped between rivals in midstretch and continued willingly. ARTA B TAPPIN chased three deep then outside a rival, continued outside on the turn and three deep into the stretch, was four wide in midstretch and edged a rival for third. HI HO YODELER dueled between horses then stalked inside on the turn, inched away nearing midstretch, fought back along the rail a sixteenth out and was edged for the show. SEETHE GIRLGO between horses early, stalked off the rail then outside, came three wide into the stretch, was between foes in midstretch and lacked the needed late kick. WARREN'S LEADGIRL broke a bit slowly, settled off the rail, went outside on the turn and four wide into the stretch and was not a threat. ROCKIN HEATHER had good early speed and dueled three deep, inched away and angled in some on the turn, was bumped and steadied between foes in midstretch and weakened. TRICK SKATE had speed inside to duel for the lead, was shuffled back some early on the turn, steadied in tight leaving the turn, came out nearing the stretch and gave way. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the incident in midstretch but made no change when they ruled the trouble to ROCKIN HEATHER did not alter the original order of finish.
