SLEEP TIGHT immediately sped to the lead inside in the chute, maintained an advantage down the backstretch and around the turn, drifted out slightly in the final eighth and held her foes safe to the wire. JAWS N' PAWS settled inside in the run down the backstretch, moved closer on the turn, came into the stretch four wide, rallied on the outside through the final furlong but had to settle for second best. ROMAN CHARITY stalked the pace on the inside down the backstretch and around the turn, came into the stretch three wide, went willingly to the wire between horses and held the show. LAKE OSCEOLA stalked outside the winner down the backstretch, went willingly to the wire inside a three horse spread in the final furlong and was edged for the show at the wire. ENTABENI hopped at the start and was off very slowly, chased on the inside throughout the journey and lacked the sufficient rally in the drive. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the start for ENTABENI and ruled that runner was the cause of her own trouble.
