EL NADIA (NZ) sped to the early lead, set all the pace along the inside, responded when the runner-up loomed in midstretch and proved best under a left handed tap of the whip and a strong hand ride. HAMEILDAEME (GB) chased inside, moved up on the second turn, came out in upper stretch to appear a threat, could not catch the winner but held second. ELEGANT chased a bit off the rail then inside on the second turn and into the stretch, came out in deep stretch and was edged for the place. RED HOT CHARLOTTE between horses early, stalked inside, came out on the second turn, went alongside a rival leaving that turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. VIKKILEE angled in on the first turn and chased outside a rival, waited momentarily off heels leaving the second turn, came three deep into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. GOOD FRIDAY GAL broke slowly, settled off the pace inside, continued along the rail on the second turn and into the stretch and was not a threat. LIVING OUR DREAM three deep early, stalked off the rail, dropped back leaving the second turn and weakened. MALUSITA pulled her way along four wide into the first turn, stalked outside then three deep into the second turn, dropped back on that turn and had little left for the stretch.
