BULLY'S DEL MAR had good early speed and dueled outside a rival, inched away past midstretch, drifted out into the path of a foe under left handed urging in deep stretch and pulled clear. ILE DE FRANCE chased outside on the backstretch and turn, drifted in a bit in upper stretch, was slightly bothered by the spill in deep stretch and edged SHEZA GLADIATOR late. SHEZA GLADIATOR dueled inside a rival to midstretch, could not match that one in the final furlong and was edged by ISLE DE FRANCE late. PUFF THE MAGIC unhurried outside on the backstretch and three deep on the turn, came a bit wider into the stretch and found her best stride late. BLENNERHASSETT bumped at the start, settled off the rail, split rivals into the stretch, was a bit bothered at the spill but lacked the needed response. PURE INSTINCT between horses early, dropped back off the rail on the backstretch, angled in for the turn, came out in upper stretch and had a mild gain but was not a threat. REAL HYPER ROAR broke slowly, saved ground, came a bit off the rail on the turn, steadied slightly to avoid the fallen rider in deep stretch and gave way. GOLD SCAMMER stalked the pace a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch, steadied then clipped heels in deep stretch and fell, then eventually got up and was vanned off. Following a stewards' inquiry, BULLY'S DEL MAR was disqualified and placed last for interference in deep stretch.
