ALPHABET KISSES sped to the early lead outside rivals, angled in on the first turn, set the pace toward the inside and held on gamely under urging. OLD CHINESE COPY stalked inside then bid outside the winner on the backstretch and second turn, battled alongside that one through a stiff drive but could not quite match strides late. FIVE NICKELS pulled her way between horses, stalked outside a rival on the first turn and three deep on the backstretch, continued outside on the second turn and three wide into the stretch to loom a threat and just held third. THE DEMPSEY LOOK angled in and was taken back early, pulled her way into a bit of a tight spot on the first turn, saved ground off the pace, came out on the second turn and again in upper stretch and just missed the show. BROAD MINDED stalked outside a rival then between horses on the backstretch and into the second turn, angled in on that bend and lacked the necessary late kick. BLACK LACE SAM chased three deep then outside on the backstretch, angled in leaving the second turn and weakened. CHURCH EDITOR angled in and chased inside, steadied hard in tight quarters entering the second turn to drop back and also weakened.
