Footnotes

O K TOPLESS three deep early, dueled between horses on the backstretch and into the turn, angled in and battled inside on the bend, inched away under urging past midstretch and held on gamely under strong handling. BRITE LORELEI four wide early, dueled three deep then outside the winner on the turn, drifted out from the whip then in under right handed pressure in the final furlong but continued willingly. CHEROKEE SPIRES forced the pace inside on the backstretch and into the turn, came off the rail and stalked on the bend, was a bit wide into the stretch and weakened but held third. HIGH SOCIETY chased off the rail then angled in and saved ground and lacked the necessary response in the stretch. TALENTED PERFORMER bumped at the start, raced between foes early, chased off the rail and was not a threat. QUEEN OF THE HUNT also bumped at the start, settled inside, dropped farther back on the turn and was done early.
