Footnotes

LAVA MAN had speed outside a rival leaving the chute then inched away into the first turn, set the pace a bit off the rail, responded when rivals bid into the second turn, inched away again and held on gamely under some urging and energetic handling. KING'S DRAMA (IRE) pulled between horses and was in a bit tight on the first turn, moved up three deep on the backstretch, bid outside foes into the second turn, continued off the rail leaving that turn and held second. RED FORT (IRE) chased inside, came out on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and just got the show. SWEET RETURN (GB) had speed inside the winner then came off the rail on the first turn and stalked outside a rival, bid between horses into the second turn, went three deep into the stretch and just lost third between foes late. ARTISTE ROYAL (IRE) pulled a bit early, stalked between horses or outside a rival, continued a bit off the inside leaving the second turn and lacked the needed rally. MOLENGAO (BRZ) unhurried and angled in outside a rival leaving the chute, split horses past midstretch with a mild late bid. T. H. APPROVAL saved ground stalking the pace, fell back on the second turn and weakened. RUNAWAY DANCER settled along the inside and saved ground to no avail. BRECON BEACON (GB) close up three deep stalking the pace, was pulled up on the backstretch and vanned off.
