LUCKY J. H. stalked inside then bid along the rail leaving the backstretch, dueled inside, gained a short lead into the stretch and gamely prevailed under urging. CAPTAIN SQUIRE sped to the early lead a bit off the rail, dueled between horses leaving the backstretch and outside the winner the rest of the way and continued willingly to the wire. PRIMERICA stalked four wide then between horses, went three deep on the turn and into the stretch and bested the others. PRORUNNER stalked five wide on the backstretch and four wide into the turn, came three deep into the stretch and weakened. KEEP ON PUNCHING close up between horses early, bid three deep leaving the backstretch, continued off the rail on the turn and also weakened. THUNDER TOUCH sent along toward the inside then outside a rival, went between foes on the turn, gave way and was eased in the final furlong. SAINT BUDDY steadied in a bit tight early, angled in and stalked inside, dropped back leaving the turn, also gave way in the stretch and was eased.
