### Footnotes

BUCK'S BRO pulled his way along to press the pace outside a rival then stalked leaving the turn, re-bid between horses in the stretch, bumped with the runner-up, and gamely prevailed late under strong handling. DARK AND DEEP had speed outside then angled in and set the pace a bit off the rail, inched away on the turn, fought back inside through the stretch, bumped with the winner and continued willingly to the wire. STREET CAR stalked inside and was in a bit tight on the backstretch, came out leaving the turn and three deep into the stretch, took the lead outside the top pair approaching midstretch and was outgamed late. RIVER ECHO chased outside a rival then three deep on the backstretch and off the rail on the turn and lacked the needed rally. CANDY LION pulled his way between horses on the backstretch, stalked outside a rival on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and weakened.
