RULER'S COURT chased inside on the backstretch, came out some on the turn, collared the pacesetter past the eighth pole while bumping with that one and pulled clear under some urging. WILD WADI between horses early, chased a bit off the rail then angled in on the turn and finished with interest inside. WESTCOAST THUNDER quickly sprinted clear, set the pace inside, drifted out to bump with the winner past midstretch and just held third. SPELLBINDER between horses early, chased outside a rival, was crowded off heels nearing the turn, came three deep into the stretch and just missed the show. CLEAR TALKER stalked the leader off the rail, angled in some leaving the turn and weakened. RUSH INTO HEAVEN unhurried off the rail on the backstretch and turn, came a bit wide into the stretch and did not rally. SKIPASLEW raced wide to the turn, continued outside and a bit wide into the stretch and was not a threat. LEGENDARY TRAITORS broke slowly and saved ground to no avail. WE ALL LOVE ALEYNA angled in and chased outside a rival, dropped back on the turn and weakened.
