Footnotes

BARDY WOMAN stalked three deep then outside a rival, bid four wide into the second turn, took the lead three wide leaving that turn, angled in some entering the stretch, had the rider lose the whip nearing midstretch but pulled clear and held under good handling. HOME ICE settled off the rail, came out four wide into the stretch and just got the place. SHE'S NOBLE dueled outside a rival then between foes, angled in on the second turn and just lost the place. RUN FOR DESSERT saved ground chasing the pace, split horses leaving the second turn, bid three deep into the stretch, had the rider lose the whip in upper stretch and lacked the needed rally. ITSCHELSEAGIRL chased between horses, bid three deep between foes to duel for the lead, fought back between rivals on the second turn but weakened in the stretch. I CAN YODELE angled in and dueled inside, fell back midway on the second turn, came out a bit into the stretch and also weakened. CRYPTO'S WILD came off the rail on the first turn, trailed off the inside throughout and was outrun.
