Footnotes

VAN BRIT three deep on the first turn, stalked outside a rival, came three wide into the stretch, gained the lead under urging outside the runner-up nearing, midstretch and inched away late. SURPRISES WELCOMED stalked between horses then off the rail or outside a rival, bid alongside the pacesetter leaving the second turn, put a head in front into the stretch, fought back inside the winner, drifted in some late and could not match that one. TUNER a bit slow to begin, chased three wide then outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and picked up the show. B. A. HOMEBODY chased between horses then off the rail, went outside a rival on the second turn and lacked the needed rally. ASPEN DIAMOND sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, duelled along the rail leaving the second turn and into the stretch, then weakened. VIOLET SKY (IRE) broke a bit slowly, settled inside, came off the rail on the backstretch, went outside a rival on the second turn, swung out into the stretch and did not rally. NIGHTNIGHTNIGHT pulled her way along inside to stalk the pace, continued along the rail on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened. GENTLEMEN'S CROWN four wide early, angled in and settled off the rail, found the fence on the second turn, came out into the stretch and was not a threat.
