Non-winners of \$90,000 at any time or \$60,000 twice in 2007-08 allowed 2 lbs.; a race of \$60,000 in 2007-08 allowed 4 lbs.; non-winners of two races other than maiden, claiming or starter in 2008 allowed 6 lbs.; of such a race in 2008, 8 lbs. Footnotes

SILKY SMOOTH chased off the rail then between foes leaving the backstretch and outside a rival on the turn, came out in upper stretch and rallied under good handling to gain the lead outside rivals in deep stretch then pulled clear. BAHAMA MAMA (IRE) between horses early, stalked a bit off the rail, came out some in the stretch, bid between rivals past midstretch, was not a match for the winner but gamely edged a rival for second. COCO BELLE sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, fought back past midstretch and saved the show. LIGHTMYFIREBABY stalked off the rail then outside a rival leaving the turn and three deep into the stretch, bid between foes past midstretch and was narrowly edged for a minor award. BRENDOLYN angled in and saved ground tracking the pace to the stretch and lacked the needed response. ANAMANOR (AUS) broke a bit slowly, settled inside, swung out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. AGAINST THE LAW chased off the rail or outside, went three deep on the turn and weakened.
