Footnotes

STACY'S HOPE chased between horses around the turn, split horses to vie for the lead in upper stretch, drew out under urging inside the furlong marker and was in hand in the final yards. BIG WAGS chased on the outside around the turn, came into the stretch four wide, rallied through the lane on the outside and was up for second on the wire. PRIDE OF WILSHIRE sped to the lead from the inside, was clear around the turn and into the lane, weakened on the inside through the lane and lost second on the wire. HOLLYWOOD MOGUL pressed the pace outside a rival into the turn, entered the stretch three wide and weakened in the final furlong. SOUTHERN VICTORY pressed inside a rival around the turn, remained in contention in upper stretch and gradually weakened in the final furlong. QUINTONS FLASH was off slowly and trailed the field to the stretch, swung out to the middle of the track for the stretch drive and could make no impact. BRING IT was off a bit slowly, raced between horses down the backstretch, angled to the rail entering the turn, remained inside for the drive and did not menace.
