Footnotes

WINSOME CHARM sped to the early lead and angled in, set the pace inside then stalked on the backstretch and second turn, re-bid along the fence in the stretch, regained the lead, drifted out some under left handed urging and gamely prevailed. ACHAK (IRE) chased inside then a bit off the rail, went outside a rival on the second turn and three deep into the stretch, rallied outside past midstretch then between horses on the wire in a game try. CROSSING THE LINE (NZ) allowed to settle alongside a rival chasing the pace, came three wide into the stretch, rallied between horses in deep stretch and continued willingly to the wire. ASPERITY stalked just off the rail then bid outside the winner to take the lead, inched away and angled in on the backstretch, set the pace inside, came a bit off the fence into the stretch, battled alongside the winner in midstretch and between foes in deep stretch and also continued willingly to the end. SIR DAVE a bit slow to begin, settled just off the rail, came out in the stretch and found his best stride late four wide on the line. KATIE'S DAN (NZ) saved ground chasing the pace, came out a bit in upper stretch then angled back in and finished with interest inside. KRIS SILVER pulled a bit and stalked outside then alongside a rival, was between horses in deep stretch and could not summon the needed late kick.
