CIRCLE THE MOON stalked off the rail then outside a rival into the turn, came into the stretch four wide, rallied on the outside in midstretch to gain the lead and was clear at the wire. GOODBYE CHARLIE broke in slightly, dueled three deep in the early going, eased back slightly to stalk on the outside into the turn, entered the stretch three wide, took the lead in midstretch, went willingly to the wire but had to settle for second best. LORD VRONSKY chased a bit off the rail down the backstretch, angled in to the rail around the turn, came out and waited off heels entering the lane, rallied between horses in the final furlong, angled to the inside late and was a clear third at the wire. HE'S SO STYLISH sped to the lead, dueled on the inside of a three horse spread in the early going, maintained the advantage on the rail to the top of the lane and weakened in the final furlong. FULL EFFECT chased inside the winner into the turn, remained on the wood for the stretch drive and lacked the necessary rally. DANCE MARINO dueled between horses then outside a rival into and around the turn, came into the stretch between horses, steadied between foes while tiring at the eighth pole and weakened. PIRATES GOLD was bumped at the start, chased down the backstretch under some urging and made no headway in the lane.
