ACCLAMATION sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, responded when challenged on the backstretch, inched away again on the second turn, kicked clear in the stretch and proved best under urging and strong handling. CELTIC NEW YEAR stalked outside a rival then off the rail, bid alongside the winner on the backstretch, had that one slip away some on the second turn, then could not match that rival in the stretch but held second. BOURBON BAY was in a good position stalking the pace outside a rival, came out four wide on the backstretch, angled to the inside into the second turn, angled out again in the stretch and was edged for the place. RED ALERT DAY (GB) pulled his way along inside to stalk the pace, came off the rail on the backstretch, angled in a bit alongside a foe on the second turn and lacked the needed late kick. HAIMISH HY angled in and settled inside chasing the pace, saved ground on the second turn and into the stretch and did not rally. FALCON ROCK (IRE) also angled in and saved ground chasing the pace, came out leaving the second turn and around a foe into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response.
