A TOAST TO YOU angled in and dueled outside the runner-up, was floated out by that one into the stretch, gained the lead in midstretch, inched away under urging and won clear. GETTING LUCKY had good early speed and dueled inside, drifted out into the stretch, fought back in midstretch while drifting in and was clearly second best. RON BURGUNDY broke a half step slowly and was bumped, settled just off the rail then outside a rival, came out in upper stretch and just got the show. BIG BAD BARRY was in a good position stalking the pace three deep to the stretch and was edged late for third. TALE BE TOLD off a bit slowly, was sent along between horses to chase the pace to the stretch and weakened. EXOTIC SLEW sent between horses to stalk the pace, fell back some passing the half mile pole, angled to the inside on the turn, came out in deep stretch and lacked the needed rally. JEFFERY'S PRIDE off a bit slowly, saved ground chasing the pace to the stretch and did not rally. HURRY HOME CLOVER pulled his way along to stalk the pace inside and was in tight off heels a half mile out, continued to stalk along the rail on the turn and weakened in the stretch.
