**Footnotes**

ZENIDEKKA broke in a bit, had speed four wide then dueled three deep on the backstretch and turn, took the lead in upper stretch, inched away past midstretch and won clear under steady handling and a long hold late. CHOKECHERYMARY broke outward and steadied, chased off the rail, moved up four wide leaving the backstretch, continued three deep on the turn and into the stretch and gained the place. PLEASING SUNRISE settled off the pace inside, went outside a rival into and on the turn, came out in upper stretch and outfinished rivals for the show three deep on the line. MISS GEORGIE GIRL chased between horses then three deep leaving the backstretch and into the turn, angled in some leaving the turn, split horses in midstretch and again at the wire and was outfinished for a minor award. YOU CAN DREAM had good early speed and dueled between horses on the backstretch and again on the turn, fought back off the rail in midstretch, then weakened. AVE ATALANTA pulled a bit and chased between horses then a bit off the rail, angled in on the turn, went around a rival in deep stretch and lacked the needed rally. CACTUS FLYER had speed off the rail then angled in and dueled inside, fought back on the turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. SUGAR SPIKE prompted the pace inside then stalked along the rail, was shuffled back into the turn and weakened. MAVICSA between horses early, chased a bit off the rail then inside, dropped back a half mile out, went around a rival leaving the turn and did not rally.
