EVEN THE SCORE chased outside, moved up four wide on the second turn and three deep into the stretch, gained the lead in upper stretch, inched away in midstretch and won clear under some urging. TOTAL IMPACT (CHI) stalked the pace outside on the first turn and backstretch, bid three deep into the second turn, battled between horses into the stretch, could not match the winner but was clearly second best. NOSE THE TRADE (GB) stalked the leaders along the inside, was bumped into the second turn, came out into the stretch and edged a rival for third. GIFT OF THE EAGLE chased outside a rival then between horses on the second turn, came three deep into the stretch and just missed the show. ENDER'S SHADOW had good early speed outside a rival, angled in leaving the first turn, inched away on the backstretch, dueled inside on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened late. BUCKLAND MANOR forced the pace outside a rival then stalked between foes, was bumped into the second turn and weakened. MUD SHARK off a bit slowly, settled inside chasing the pace and did not rally. GENE DE CAMPEAO (BRZ) bobbled at the start, lagged back inside, came out into the stretch and was not a threat.
